



## How to Make a Category Game in MS Word

### Print directions

Type a Title: **The Category Game**. **Center** this title. **Save**.

Click on **Table, Insert, Table**. Make **4 columns & 9 rows**. **Save**.

In the **1st column**, write the word **CATEGORY** - 1 letter per row. **Save**.

In the 1st row, 2nd column write: **Foods**, 3rd column: **Cities**, 4th column: **Animals**. **Save**.

Select everything (**Edit, Select All**). Make the font size **20**, and **center** justify. **Save**.

Print one copy, and then make enough for your whole class on the copy machine.

## How to make a Category Game

### Student created - play on computer

Type a Title: **The Category Game** by (put in your name). **Center** this title. **Save**.

Click on **Table, Insert, Table**. Make **4 columns & 9 rows**. **Save**.

In the **1st column**, write the word **CATEGORY** - 1 letter per row. **Save**.

In the 1st row, 2nd column write: **Foods**, 3rd column: **Cities**, 4th column: **Animals**. **Save**.

Select everything (**Edit, Select All**). Make the font size **20**, and **center**. **Save**.

Select all the cells in the **2nd column (Food)**. Change the font size to **16**. Change the letter color to **red**. **Save**.

Select all the cells in the **3rd column (Cities)**. Change the font size to **16**. Change the letter color to **blue**. **Save**.

Select all the cells in the **4th column (Animals)**. Change the font size to **16**. Change the letter color to **green**. **Save**.

Fill in all empty cells. Can you think of words for each category that start with the letter???

Save as you go!

**\*\* Note:** Instead of the word **CATEGORY**, have students use their name, or a word of your choice (**SCIENCE, DINOSAUR, etc**)

Also, use your own categories: e.g. for **MATTER**, use solid, liquid, & gas.
