

Adding Sound Effects to PowerPoint



1. Sound effect 'buttons'

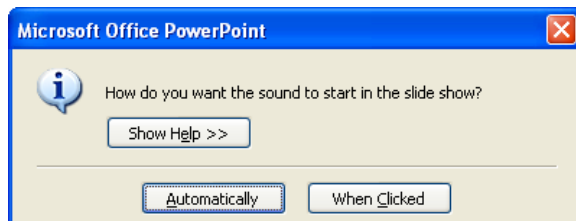
In PowerPoint, click on:

Insert

Movies and Sounds

Sound from File

This will open a window from which you can locate the sound effect that you like.



Isn't PowerPoint polite??

Choose how you'd like your sound to start.

This will give you the sound icon that looks like.



You can resize and move it where ever you want.

You can find more sound effects on the Internet or you can purchase cds with sound effects.

If you import sounds from another source (like the Internet), save the sounds to the same folder that contains your PowerPoint. That's where PowerPoint will look for your sounds, so that's the best place to put them.
