October 19, 2000

Meeting called to order @ 6:20.

1. Welcome and sign in
2. Treasurer's report given by Jeri Grover. Line items were discussed and addressed the possibility of removing some line items to increase funds for other items/areas.
3. Fundraiser Update- \$15,992.50 in potential sales. Would receive ½ of monies collected for profit. Delivery is scheduled for Friday, October 23rd @ 8:00 am. Discussed sending flyer home to parents regarding collecting money or returning items. Can collect straight donations to school. Donations are 100% profit. Money is due October 30th.

Old business:

1. Meet the teacher night- great to have snacks in each classroom. Mrs. Stout commented on PA system not being very loud in the gym but the gym is still the best choice. Great attendance.

New business:

1. Discuss fundraiser options for spring/fall: should think about spring fundraiser. Walk~A~thon was a great fundraiser. Would sign with Midland if choose a company next year. Need to think about if we want to even go with a company. Suggestions of a silent auction were brought up. Kristi Fuller suggested committing to a spring walk~a~thon and not committing with company for fall without further investigation.
2. Plan for monthly social activities- Kristi Fuller reviewed the goals of the PTO. Marcy Stout brought forth concerns and questions from staff regarding events. Staff would like to reduce the number of events. Staff confused about PTO classroom monies. If not signed up, no money given or no money until the time they volunteer. Kristi offered answers and clarification of these questions. Suggestion made to have a PTO questionnaire to poll staff of what they would like from the PTO and how staff and PTO can work better together. Staff would like to do all academic nights and all other social nights should be covered by PTO volunteers. Frustrations were shared by both sides.
3. Halloween spooktacular- Flyers and info will be sent home with kids.
4. From the Principal- Marcy Stout brought forth Kelly Mogg requesting 1-2 new library tables. Price approximately \$323 each plus \$100 shipping. Motion to approve the purchase of 2 tables by Jeri Grover, second by Kristi Fuller.
5. PEAK- Renee Gilbert Thursday is Nationwide "Lights on after school". Field trip to Spinning wheels for all PEAK sites and families. Event is FREE. Paper light bulbs are being sold for \$1 with proceeds going to PEAK scholarship fund.
