For use with Kindergarten

Children will act out the story of The Three Little Pigs with stick puppets. I will use a digital camera to take pictures of the children performing in sequence. I will then take the pictures and put them in order. I will use Kids Pix Deluxe to put the slide show together. We will display the slide show to reinforce sequencing the story.

Teacher Preparation:

- Students have heard the story “The Three Little Pigs”
- Students have practiced their own parts of the play.
- Pictures have been taken and installed on Kids Pix
- Students need to know how to create and save a slide show.

Activities/Procedures:

Students will put on the puppet show “The Three Little Pigs”

- Students will put the digital pictures in order according to the story.
- Students will record their voices telling the story in sequence.
- Students will create a slide show in Kid Pix Deluxe.
